




Parental monitoring involves laying out clear expectations, regularly checking in, and consistently enforcing rules with rewards and consequences.


# WHEN PARENTS AREN'T ATTENTIVE, TEENS BELIEVE IT EASY TO GET DRUGS AND ALCOHOL.

Teens are aware when their parents are paying attention to what they do. Inattentiveness can encourage your teens to test the limits.


Monitoring is an important part of parenting, and can help your child keep safe from risky behavior, such as alcohol and drug use. You may not think your teen is listening, but as a parent, you have powerful influence on their behavior.

#### HOW SERIOUS IS THIS ISSUE?


In 8th grade, about **35%** of students report that they would **never get caught** by their parents if they drank alcohol without their parents' permission.



By the time students get into high school, this number **nearly doubles to 60%**.
